Our program is tailored to individuals who are ready to commit to full-time dance training and have the required physical ability, drive, and determination to flourish in the industry.



FEES & COSTING


YEAR 10, 11 & 12

For students in Year 10, 11, and 12, the program fee at Accent On Dance is \$6,350. The academic study at Thebarton Senior College is \$590 a year. The program entails attending AOD Elite three days a week from 9am to 3:30pm, with the remaining two days allocated to academic studies.



CERTIFICATE

Completion of a Certificate III will require two years of dedication and a fee of \$2,100. Additionally, a technique and/or ballet and jazz technique class at Accent On Dance or current dance school must be undertaken, either during school hours or after school.
